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Mobility Lifeline Guidelines

This transportation program is provided by Monroe Community Senior Center and is partially funded by a grant from The City of Monroe.

1. Riders must be 60+ years of age or 18+ and disabled.
2. Each ride, each way will cost \$1.50. For example, if we pick you up at home, bring you to MCSC, take you to Fred Meyer and then home, the cost would be \$6.00. Punch cards are available for purchase at the Senior Center and will be kept on the bus for the driver to punch each ride.
3. Transportation services operate on Mondays, Thursdays, and Fridays, excluding holidays. First pick-up is at 8:30 a.m. and the last drop off is at 3:30 p.m.
4. There is a 20-minute window of time for pick-up and drop-off.
5. Three days' notice and a minimum of 24 hours' notice is required to use this service. We cannot guarantee that time slots will be available for your designated time. 24 hours' notice is requested if a ride needs to be cancelled.
6. ALL rides will be scheduled on a first-come first-serve basis through the front desk at MCSC (360-794-6359.) Rides may not be changed or scheduled through the driver.
7. Once the Standing Ride Form is completed, reviewed and approved by the Program Coordinator at MCSC the standing rides will be put on the schedule. Shopping trips may not be booked as a standing ride but can be booked on one week in advance by calling MCSC.
8. If you have three no show/no call, (bus arrives for scheduled pick up and rider isn't there or refuses ride for whatever reason) you will not be able to use the standing ride option and will have to call in to request your ride in the future.
9. Weight including wheelchair or scooter may not exceed 400 pounds.
10. All riders must be able to self-transfer. Drivers are only able to lift items such as walkers and groceries weighing less than 25 pounds.
11. Pets are allowed as long as proof of health and immunizations are provided, the pet is friendly, well-behaved, and is appropriately leashed or kenneled.

12. Smoking, chewing tobacco, open alcohol containers, firearms, or weapons of any kind are NOT permitted on the bus.
