



Social Media Policy

MCSC's social media is not intended as a discussion forum; but as a marketing tool to promote the Center and its events to the public.

Reasons MCSC may remove or not approve a post/comment are listed below:

- Abusive, rude, defamatory, obscene or profane language
- Personal attacks, threatening or discriminatory language
- Misleading or helping to spread false information/accusations
- Posts that are meant to divide or start a debate
- Off-topic or irrelevant information
- Spam
- Promotion of illegal or questionable activities
- Promotion of a business for profit or commercial transaction

Posts/comments will not be edited or modified to remove unacceptable content; the entire post/comment will be deleted.

In general, be considerate, be helpful, be positive!

MCSC Executive Director reserves the right to ban from MCSC's social media platforms users who violate the social media policy. An appeal to the MCSC Board may be made within 10 days. The Board's decision is final and not appealable.
